






PLAY-BASED LEARNING



- 3. Give areas simple names
- 4. Identify each area with a sign or visual clue
- 5. Be sure every area is visible at all times
- 6. Use a variety of natural materials
- 7. Choose elements for durability and low maintenance
- 8. Maximize beauty and visual clarity
- 9. Personalize the design
- 10. Meet regulatory standards
