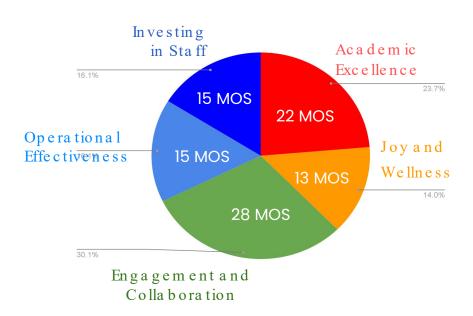

83% of Measures of Success showed improvement from baseline during Year 1

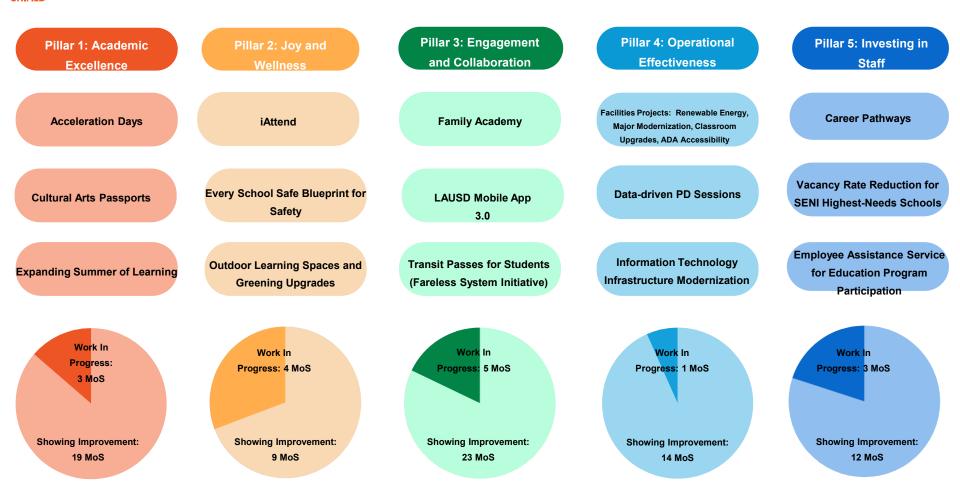
19 of the 93 Measures of Success have already met their 2026 goal (20%)

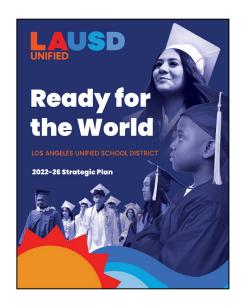

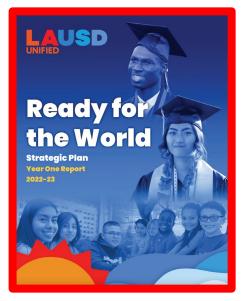

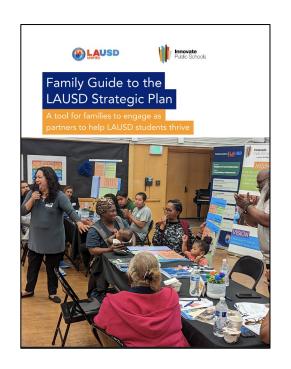
