



BY LAW, SCHOOL-AGED CHILDREN IN ONE OF THE FOLLOWING SITUATIONS MAY BE ENTITLED TO EDUCATIONAL RIGHTS AND SUPPORT IF THEY LACK A FIXED, REGULAR AND ADEQUATE NIGHTIME RESIDENCE, WHICH MAY INCLUDE:

- Living in a shelter, motel or hotel
- Living in an automobile
- Living in campgrounds, temporarily in a trailer, or park
- Living in an abandoned building or public place
- Living in substandard housing (i.e. no running water, no electricity)
- Living in a transitional housing program
- Staying doubled up with friends or relatives, due to loss of housing from financial hardship

Ask your school office for a copy of the Student Housing Questionnaire which is available in multiple languages. Every school has a designated Homeless Liaison to provide support to students and families. All information shared is confidential and will only be used by school district employees and will not be shared with any persons or agencies outside of LAUSD. Any information you submit is for school purposes only and will help to connect your child and family to resources such as school supplies, transportation to school, clothing, tutoring, and more.
