What is the responsibility of the PAC? The primary responsibility of the Parent Advisory Committee (PAC) is to provide comments to the LAUSD Superintendent and Board of Education regarding the District's Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP), as described in the CA Education Code, section 52062. Comments for the LCAP can be specific to the needs and resources provided to English Learners, Foster Youth, and low-income students.

What are the benefits of being a PAC member?

PAC members are able to learn about the District's plan to support the student achievement of various subgroups of students and make recommendations to improve the plan. They are able to collaborate with other parents, caretakers and guardians from across the District and meet District leaders. The unique role of the PAC allows its members to have a strong voice as parents, caretakers and legal guardians to influence how students are supported.

How many meetings are members expected to attend? PAC members are expected to attend the meetings below. Meetings are hosted online by the Office of Parent and Community Services from 2pm to 5pm.
