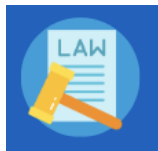




## Celebrating the 34<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Americans with Disability Act (ADA)

### Did you know...

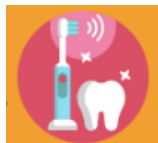
ADA defines a person with a disability as a person who has a physical or mental impairment that substantially limits one or more major life activity.



ADA was signed into law on July 26, 1990.

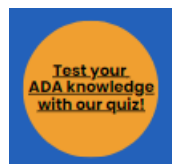


According to the [Centers for Disease Control and Prevention](#), approximately 1 in 4 adults in the United States has a disability.
