The farm specializes in high-quality date varieties, including Medjool, Zahidi, Barhi, Dayri, and more. Mark runs the operation using regenerative farming practices often accompanied by free-roaming cattle in the date groves

Regenerative Farming means farming in a way that heals the land, keeps the soil alive, and makes food healthier for people and the planet.

Community & Educational Initiatives

The farm runs structured field trips, developed in collaboration with educators to align with California's Common Core curriculum. Students engage in interactive "activations" around the farm followed by a picnic and Q&A session
