

Modi Apples Modi Apples are modern apples developed in Italy in the late 1990s. They have dark red skin and creamy flesh, reminiscent of their parents, Liberty and Gala aaples. This is a very crisp and crunchy apple. The flavor is sweeter than Gala's but also has plenty of acid. Modi ripens quite early but can easily be kept for 6 months in commercial storage.

Modi Apples are now produced in many warm-climate apple-growing areas, including Australia, Chile, and *California*. This variety likes warm temperatures.

The name 'Modi' was apparently inspired by the Italian artist Amedeo Modigliani, who was known as 'Modi' to his friends. His portraits often featured strong colors, and the Modi apple is also known for its deep red color.
