COMMUNITY SCHOOLS IN ACTION



- Graduation rates up from 51% in 2000 to 82% in 2010
- Achievement gap between **Black & white students** narrowed from 14.5% in 2003 to 1.2% in 2010



- Number of schools with after-school programs rose from 32 to 90
- 10x more children with access to summer school
- School-based health clinics



COMMUNITY SCHOOLS

- 27% more students meet early literacy benchmarks
- 79% of 2010 grads pursued post-secondary education, above state average



- Reading proficiency +10% since 2009
- After-school programs proven to maintain and increase math, reading, & writing peformance
