SUBJECT: AIR QUALITY ADVISORY FOR SEPTEMBER 27, 2023

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) forecasts air quality levels on Wednesday, September 27, 2023, to be “unhealthy for sensitive groups” for communities located within the West San Fernando Valley and San Gabriel Mountains. Sensitive or susceptible persons, including children, older adults, and those with heart or lung disease should minimize outdoor activity.
