**SUBJECT: AIR QUALITY ADVISORY THROUGH JULY 10, 2025**

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) has issued an Ozone Advisory through July 10, 2025, for the inland parts of the South Coast Air Basin including most areas within the Los Angeles Unified School District boundaries. Air quality may reach “unhealthy for sensitive groups” or higher levels in most areas within District boundaries due to elevated ozone air pollution from the heat wave affecting the region. Sensitive or susceptible persons, including children, older adults and those with heart or lung disease, should minimize outdoor activity.

OEHS will continue to monitor air quality conditions and provide updates as necessary. Please share this information as needed.
