SUBJECT: AIR QUALITY ADVISORY FOR JULY 3, 2025

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) forecasts air quality levels on July 3, 2025, to be “unhealthy for sensitive groups” for communities located within the San Gabriel Mountains. Sensitive or susceptible persons, including children, older adults and those with heart or lung disease, should minimize outdoor activity. Everyone should discontinue prolonged, vigorous outdoor exercise lasting longer than one hour. Examples of the kinds of outdoor activities that should be avoided are calisthenics, basketball, running, soccer, football, tennis, swimming laps, and water polo. Susceptible persons, such as those with heart or lung disease, should avoid outdoor activity entirely. Refer to the attached map of schools that fall within this designated area.

OEHS will continue to monitor air quality conditions and provide updates as necessary. Please share this information as needed.
