

Frequently Asked Questions (For Carlos' page)

Q. Will legal problems lead Atlas to shut down?

1. The mounting legal action at S&W Atlas Metals Inc. could lead to the business closing down or moving to another site. A metal recycling business should neither be near a school nor in a residential area because of threats to human health. With more court dates in the coming months, we expect to learn more about the company's plans.

Q. When will the Los Angeles Unified lawsuit be resolved?

A. The lawsuit was filed in 2020, and while there has been progress, the case is still pending. We are pushing for a resolution and hope one emerges later this year. Keep watching jordanhighschool.net for when it happens.

Q. With the new school year beginning, are any changes expected at Jordan High?

A. Atlas' operations have significantly decreased over the past 6 months due to our efforts and those of the District Attorney and the community. We expect them to continue to decrease over the next six months.
