Your opinions may be provided to the investigating official. Your statement will be used within LAUSD to support corrective actions, further safety and security investigations/reviews, sharing of lessons learned, and other administrative reasons. Your statement may be provided to LAUSD & the LAUSD OCIP Insurance Broker & Carrier in the furtherance of contractual obligations.
