


The Safety Valet Program enhances the safety of all students when traveling to school. The Valet creates a special drop-off zone where parent volunteers assist students out of the cars during morning drop-off. Drivers do not need to park or get out of their vehicles to be certain that their students are arriving at school safely! This eliminates many traffic challenges caused by people trying to drop-off their students and helps make the school zone safer for all!

- Manage Valet safety equipment placement in the mornings.
- Wear a highly visible vest to guide drivers into the Safety Valet and to indicate where to stop to safely open the vehicle door to assist students.
- Assist students as they exit the vehicle and guide them into school with a friendly smile that helps parents and students start the day on a great note!
