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#### A. Introduction

The District issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) for Cooperative and Harmonious Play with the goal of contracting a "bench" of vendors/providers that schools and offices can purchase from.

Fourteen (14) vendors were selected to support the supplemental physical activity programs within the District. Vendors on this bench will implement a supplemental physical activity program with an aim to provide practice opportunities for children to improve and foster positive relationships in the playground among students in Transitional Kindergarten (TK) through Grade 8. For schools that take advantage of the benefits of the program, the Contractor, will include a variety of games, inclusive to all students, skill levels, abilities and will adapt to meet the school's need. The program will require Social Emotional Learning (SEL) skills and empower children through a physical activity program and teach them the skills to be good problem solvers and exhibit successful conflict resolution. Additionally, the program will focus on providing opportunities for students to practice and refine their basic locomotive and manipulative skills such as skipping, running, kicking, throwing, catching, and jumping.

The program can be implemented during recesses, before/after school, and during grade level planning, as an option to provide teacher release during the school day depending on the school's need.

#### **B.** Contracting Procedure

#### D. Summary of Services and Prices

Contractor will develop and implement a supplemental physical activity program with an aim to provide practice opportunity for children to improve and foster positive relationships in the playground among students in Transitional Kindergarten (TK) through Grade 8.

For schools that take advantage of the benefits of the program, the Contractor, will include a variety of games, inclusive to all students, skill levels, abilities and will adapted to meet the school's need. The program will require Social Emotional Learning (SEL) skills and empower children through a physical activity program and teach them the skills to be good problem solvers and exhibit successful conflict resolution. Additionally, the program will focus on providing opportunities for students to practice and refine their basic locomotive and manipulative skills such as skipping, running, kicking, throwing, catching, and jumping.

The program can be implemented during recesses, before/after school, and during grade level planning, as an option to provide teacher release during the school day depending on the school's need.

For each school to which Contractor agrees to provide an activity program, the Contractor will make available at least one (1) staff person qualified to manage the activities, who will, in fact, manage them. A qualified staff person will be CPR and First-Aid certified, have training in movement activities, experience working with children, and have SEL training on competencies and practices within the first six (6) months of employment. To "manage" the program activities, the on-site staff person will run the games, direct the physical activity and ensure that all students are involved, kept safe, and having fun.

To the extent the Contractor is unwilling or unable, through no fault of the District's, to provide service on any particular day, the school and the Contractor will agree on dates on which the Contractor can make up the time or, if they cannot agree or if the time for the period in question (day, month, quarter or year) has expired, charges for the period will be pro-rated to reflect the actual number of hours or days on which services are actually provided.

#### Contractor duties:

- 1. Any platform used by the Contractor to provide services shall comply with the provisions of Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act, Children's Online Privacy Protection Act and other Federal and California laws with respect to confidential information.
- 2. Contractor warrants that if Contractor uses software or a software application to provide educational services, Contractor has received approval from the District's UDIPP process prior to performing any services using software/a software application.

- 3. Any and all services to students under this Agreement shall be provided Monday through Friday between the hours of 7:00 am -4:00 pm Pacific Time during non-instructional time. Specific days and times will be specified in the Purchase order issued.
- 4. No virtual services or communications shall be provided without supervision and verification of student identity by Certificated District staff. Any email communications shall include the student's parent and District staff. Contractor shall reschedule in the event the School's designated supervisor is not available for previously scheduled services.
- 5. Contractor shall not take photographs of students or record students via audio or video at any time for any reason.
- 6. Contractor shall not collect personally identifiable information, request students or parents to participate in surveys or evaluations, or recruit or solicit additional participants through students or parents.
- 7. Contractor shall comply with District's Code of Conduct with Students.
- 8. Contractor acknowledges that student work products belong to the students, and Contractor shall not use, publish, distribute or create derivative work of District students' work product in any manner.
