The Broad has developed an online curriculum connected to the exhibition, *Joseph Beuys: In Defense of Nature* and the reforestation project, *Social Forest: Oaks of Tovaangar*, centering Tongva culture through the lens of people, place, science, and art, as part of the Getty's PST ART initiative. For participating LAUSD teachers, a Schoology-friendly curriculum has been created within the LAUSD Climate Literacy Schoology group.
