Ethnic studies update:

Commissioner recommends being mindful of time lines for UC approval for ethnic studies. New course is being written by a woman in Fremont.

Germaine Watts and Wittig gave multi-point rubric for ethnic studies.

The District has revised its stance on ethnic studies and will be offering it as an elective, not a requirement, but it will meet A-G requirements.

Commissioner Wilson has the materials Julia Bogan created on the Tongva people.

Commissioner Rivlin advocates for inclusion of religious diversity.

Commissioner Reynolds advocates for recognition of immigration.

Inquired as to inclusion of Asians.

Dr. Chau is welcoming of professional development for teachers. Watts recommends that the commission elevates visibility of ethnic studies and facilitates access to the Museum of Tolerance (MOT) program.

The MOT has a grant that enables them to customize content for educators. Yvonne Contreras from LACOE may be a viable partner. Grant includes admission, food, presenters, and materials. The grant covers transportation and accommodations for those who are from outside the area.

The Commission could be a resource for ethnic studies professional development.

Obie Slamon, Michele Wittig, Joyce Germaine Watts, Beverly LeMay, David Reynolds, Allan Kakassy and Gary de la Rosa will ask to meet with Chau to present professional development opportunities.

Letter was sent to the board asking for a letter on Islamaphobia. Wittig has been in touch with Board Member Zimmer on the sponsorship.

Rivlin did not get a response from BM Ratliff's office.

BM McKenna will consider co-sponsoring

Upcoming from ADL being an Ally to Muslim

Judy is compiling materials and resources on Muslims, Islam, and religious based extremism and violence. Considering packaging it as a Peace Movement. JC is looking at ADL, Teaching Tolerance, MPAC, MPV, etc.

Kakassy and Jacobs talked about Hands Across the Campus and other activities for student engagement.

Toma recommended connecting with other human relations agencies and California Associations of Human Relations Organizations and IAOHRA. CAHRO is centered out of Robin Toma's office and partner with Dept of Justice and the city Human Relations.
