K-2 FOUNDATIONAL SKILLS Overall structure and design of foundational skills mini-lessons, connections to phonemic awareness and phonics continuums, scope & sequence, connections to shared reading and writing, and review of additional materials including leveled texts and Advancing Phonics Skills. Practice, review, and apply foundational skills in context with Shared Reading texts.	3-6 READING MINI-LESSONS Overall structure of reading instruction and how teachers support students as they read and annotate complex text. Analytical reading skills including application of text analysis in collaborative conversations and writing to sources. Planning the block with whole and small group instruction.
