AAL Resource Allocation Request 2017-18 Due Date: April 21, 2017

The Accelerated Academic Literacy (AAL) funding is allocated to schools who have structured an intensive intervention ELA program as outlined in the upcoming MEM-6382.0, *Placement Guidelines Language Arts Tier 2 and Tier 3 Intervention Programs in Grades 6 through 9.* In order for schools to receive the auxiliary funding, the following requirements must be met:

- English core class (e.g., English 7A, English 9A, etc.), **general education only**, must be double-blocked with the intensive intervention course: Literacy for Success (middle school) or Strategic Literacy (high school)
- The English core class and the intervention class must be taught by the same teacher
- An evidence-based replacement curriculum, such as *Read 180 or Language!* 4 Edition, must be used that meets the intensive intervention needs of the students

Special Day Program (SDP) classes do not qualify for AAL funding.

Final AAL funding allocation will be based on Norm Day enrollment.
