MILK SERVICE GUIDANCE

Please follow the guidance below and contact your Nutrition Specialist if you have any questions.

- 1. Must serve at least two different kinds of milk at each meal, except EEC can offer one milk option.
- 2. Offering more than two different options is allowed if the guidelines below are followed (except EEC see exceptions below).
 - One of the options must be Unflavored Milk.
- 3. No flavored milk allowed at Breakfast for any grade.
- 4. EEC: No flavored milk at any meal and only offer the 6 oz. carton for White Low-Fat Milk. See exceptions below.
