The Supervision Course is offered to all Food Service employees.

Topics covered include Human Resources, Time Management, Delegation, Communication, Leadership Skills, etc.

CLASS EDUCATION QUALIFICATIONS:



The supervision certificate earned meets LAUSD's entrance education qualification to promote to the following classifications:

Senior Food Service Worker - Successful completion of a minimum of three semester units or equivalent of adult school or college-level courses in supervision, or completion of a corporate-sponsored training course in supervision, or the completion of the District's supervision course is preferable.

Food Service Manager I-VII - Graduation from high school or evidence of equivalent educational proficiency and evidence of successful completion of adult school, college-level, or equivalent classes in supervision.

Managers that wish to take this course and already attain a required certificate are more than welcome to attend and refresh on their leadership skills.

*Completions of EPIC Hours and the course workbook is required to obtain a supervision certificate.

HOW TO REGISTER



STEP 1: Scan the QR code. Complete and submit the registration form for interested courses.

STEP 2: Once registration is closed, you will receive an email confirmation notifying your scheduled enrollment of the course.
