

Best Practice For The Immersion Blender Whisk Attachment.

This process outlines the safety practices for attaching and removing the whisk.

Note: Before attaching or removing any parts, **unplug the blender**.

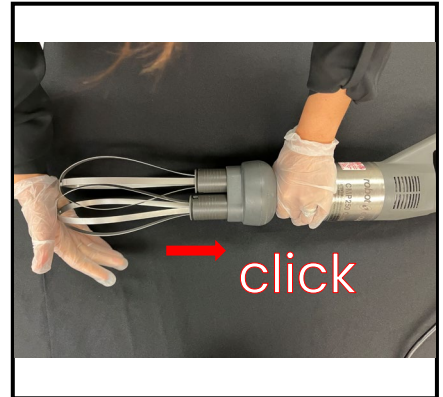
Attaching the whisks



The Immersion Blender CMP 250 Combi includes a whisk and whisk shaft.

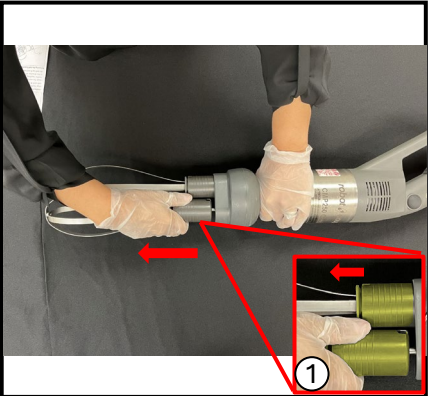


Step 1: Attach the Whisk Shaft to the motor unit:
Insert the whisk shaft into the motor and turn the whisk holder counterclockwise until it locks.

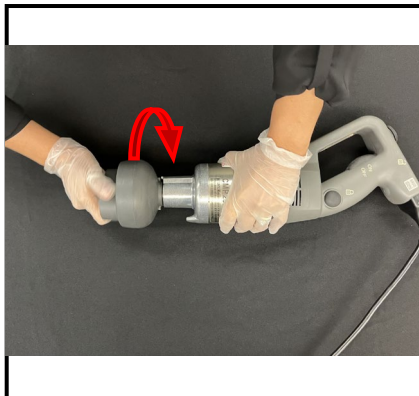


Step 2: Attach whisks to the whisk shaft.
Insert the whisk into the whisk shaft. You should hear a click, then gently pull on the metal wires to check security.

Removing the whisks



Step 1: Remove the whisks: pull down on the whisk ejectors to release whisks as seen on diagram 1



Step 2: Remove the whisk shaft: Turn the whisk holder counterclockwise and remove it when it stops by pulling



Step 3: Storage: After attachments have been washed, sanitized, and dry, place all parts in an 18 qt. Cambro replacing the wiper at the bottom after every use. Be sure to label the Cambro and store in a safe location.
