Overview: Grade 5 Content Integration Performance Task

Culminating Task

After analyzing historical primary sources and conducting scientific investigations and research, groups of students will design a presentation to convince a panel of experts from NASA to fund their unique space colony proposal.

Interim Writing Task:

Using evidence from the historical documents you have analyzed and scientific research you have conducted, write an opinion essay that answers the essential question:

What do people need to survive and thrive in a new environment?

PROMPT:

In your opinion, what are the three most significant factors (using the list below) that increase the chances of survival in a new environment?

• Factors include: location, ability to solve problems, shelter, economic purpose, government, and occupations.

Essential Question: What do human beings need to survive and thrive in a new environment?
