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#### Choices Process for 2024-2025 Enrollment

Applying for Gifted Magnets and Schools for Advanced Studies

This year's on-time 2024-2025 Choices application window opens on Monday, October 2, 2023, and closes on Friday, November 17, 2023. Online applications are encouraged since parents/guardians will receive notification letters via email. To submit your application online, visit: GoTo.LAUSD.net. You may also submit a paper application by picking up a Choices brochure at your child's school or Region/District Offices. For descriptions of all Choices programs including Schools for Advanced Studies (SAS) and Gifted Magnets, visit echoices.lausd.net. Here are some helpful tips when applying:



- Be sure to submit your application on or before the Friday, November 17, 2023, deadline (online or postmarked).
- Carefully review all eligibility requirements before applying.
- If you are applying to Gifted Magnets or Schools for Advanced Studies (SAS) and your child is enrolled in a Los Angeles Unified school, including the Virtual Academy and City of Angels, the District will automatically review eligibility through a District verification process in January 2024. Please contact your child's Los Angeles Unified school of attendance for more information about this process.
- If you are applying to Gifted Magnets or Schools for Advanced Studies (SAS) and your child is enrolled in a non-district school, request and confirm that the school of attendance has submitted the Verification of Eligibility form on or before the Friday, November 17, 2023 deadline (email or postmarked). Forms are available beginning Monday, October 2, 2023 at <a href="https://echoices.lausd.net">https://echoices.lausd.net</a> (select "SAS" and "Who is eligible?").
- If you are applying to Gifted Magnets or Schools for Advanced Studies (SAS) and your child is homeschooled (without a verifying organization) or not enrolled in school, you must contact <a href="mailto:GATE@lausd.net">GATE@lausd.net</a> on or before the November 17, 2023 deadline to initiate the verification process. Detailed information will be available beginning October 2, 2023 at https://lausd.org/gate (select Program Options and SAS).
- If you are applying to a Highly Gifted Magnet, parents/guardians may contact Gifted/Talented Programs at (213) 241-4177 or <a href="mailto:GATE@lausd.net">GATE@lausd.net</a> to verify eligibility.
- Late applications and Verification of Eligibility forms, if applicable, will not be accepted for or included in the on-time Choices process. For non-identified applicants, the eligibility recommendation submitted by the principal of the current school of attendance is final.
- Virtual and in-person Choices Fairs will be held in October and November. Information will be provided about all Choices program options. Visit https://GoTo.LAUSD.net and select Choices Fairs.

Be identified as gifted by
Los Angeles Unified in the
Intellectual, High
Achievement, Specific
Academic, Creative, or
Leadership Ability Category



#### **HAVE SCORES**

Scored in the Standard
Exceeded range on the
2023 Smarter Balanced
Assessment or received a
national percentile score of
85 or above on a Districtapproved standardized test
(most recent year only)



#### **BE VERIFIED**

Be verified as eligible by the current school of attendance as meeting the Critical Thinking/Problem Solving Skills Criteria.

Note: Applicants to kindergarten SAS must also meet kindergarten-specific criteria

#### **BE IDENTIFIED**

Be identified as highly gifted (percentile score of 99.9) on an intellectual assessment administered by a Los Angeles Unified designated GATE psychologist



#### **BE IDENTIFIED**

Be identified as gifted with a percentile score of 99.5-99.8 (considered "highly gifted applicable") on an intellectual assessment administered by a Los Angeles Unified designated GATE psychologist
