

ATTENDANCE POLICY PUNCTUALITY

February, 2014

Dear Parents/Guardians:



Our records indicate that a situation has arisen on our campus that demands we re-visit our current attendance policy as it relates to our students lack of punctuality (tardiness). The aforementioned is particularly evident at the beginning of our school day which begins at 7:45 A.M. Too many students are arriving late to homeroom with an alarming percentage of students missing homeroom completely.

Education research indicates punctuality is vital to student achievement. Students who develop

patterns of good attendance are much more likely to succeed both academically and socially.

Good attendance matters greatly!

- When students are on time, they get better grades, score better on standardized tests and are more likely to remain on course for college/career-readiness.
- It is the responsibility of home and school to teach students the importance of punctuality now so they are prepared for the future. Employers say good attendance demonstrates responsibility and is a key factor in the hiring and promotion of employees.
- It is the law! (California Education Code Section 48200) Parents and Guardians are responsible for ensuring that their children attend school and are practicing good habits of punctuality as they arrive at their sundry locations throughout the day. (A recent data collection indicates that approximately eighty-seven percent (87%) of our student population is arriving to school on time. This falls well short of the district mandate of ninety-seven percent (97%) in-seat attendance.

In order to eradicate the issue of our students' lack of punctuality we are going to begin recording the names of those students who are late. They will then be assigned Saturday detention. Those who fail to attend Saturday detention will be issued a letter of INTENT TO SUSPEND the following Monday which requires a parent to attend a conference with the Principal, Assistant Principal or one of the Behavior Intervention Specialists before the student can return to school the next day. Students who continue to arrive late or who are found to be truant are subject to legal ramifications imposed by the City of Los Angeles and the Los Angeles Unified School District including, but not limited to: citations to court, mandatory individual or family counseling sessions and referral to the jurisdiction of the juvenile court.
