



Behavior Fairs are held in the Fall and Spring to teach and reinforce behavior expectations at Purche.


All kindergarten students receive weekly lessons in Second Step from Graduate Social Work Interns to help them master new social skills.

Each month we host a Purche Fun Day to motivate students to make positive behavior choices. Past Fun Day activities have included:


- Playground Carnival

Golden Tickets can be redeemed for prizes once per month at the <u>Purche Store</u>.


Golden Tickets can also be used to become <u>"Principal</u> for the Day" or to have <u>"Lunch with the Principal."</u>

#### Principal for the Day



The Reconnection Room was launched at Purche during the 2011-2012 school year. The Reconnection Room serves as an alternative to suspension, and safe place for students to talk about their behavior, think about what they could have done differently, and learn skills to help them make better decisions.





#### What Happens in The Reconnection Room?

- •Once referred, students spend five days of morning recess in the Re-Connection room.
- •Students will receive lessons in problem solving, managing feelings, impulse-control, and character education to help them reconnect with their teacher and the students in their classroom.
- •The Reconnection Room is staffed by a Psychiatric Social Worker, Graduate and Bachelor Level Social Work Interns, and classified staff members.


#### **Positive Panther Connection**

"Positive Panther Connection" is a mentoring group of caring adult staff members of Purche Avenue Elementary School. The program is designed to:

- Help students achieve greater success in their educational, social, and emotional growth.
- Provide an opportunity for a child to make a connection with someone other than a parent or guardian that cares about them and lets them know that they are not alone in dealing with the day-to-day challenges that they may face in school.
