portable toilets (buckets), privacy screens or tarps

Hand Cleaning*

waterless hand cleaner, hand sanitizer

Drinking Water*

emergency water barrels (emergency bin), water bottles (in some classrooms),

Date emergency water barrels filled and treated*

Water expiration date (3 years from filled/treated date)*

Food Service*

emergency rations (emergency bin, classrooms), emergency food bars (emergency bin), cafeteria food (school purchased)

Fire Suppression*

fire extinguishers; post fire watch

open windows and doors, restrict activity, battery operated/rechargeable/manual fans, relocate to alternate site	
Electric Lights*	
flashlights, emergency lanterns, natural light, relocate to alternate site

sweaters/jackets, relocate to alternate site

landline telephone, email, PA system, two-way radio
