Tracking Progress on SES Items for the Strategic Plan

Strategic Plan SES Metrics and Goals-2022-2026 “Progress Tracker”

- ✓ The “Progress Tracker” is an Excel file that will enable each school to easily track progress from the Fall 2021 baseline to the Spring 2026 Goal for each SES item.
- ✓ There is a separate tab for each school level (**Elementary**, **Middle**, and **High School**) because some Strategic Plan goals vary across levels.
- ✓ Schools just need to input “**Fall 2021 SCHOOL Baseline %**” results in *Column G* for each item. All results are in the [2021-22 SES Results Dashboard](#).
- ✓ The initial Fall 2022 target is automatically calculated once the Fall 2021 baseline is entered for each item. Subsequent targets adjust depending on results each year so that the 2026 School Target can be achieved.

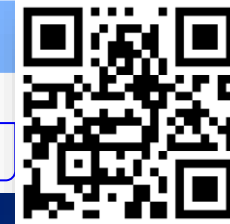
