#### All potential English Learners need to be assessed with the Initial ELPAC by OCTOBER 3, 2023:

- A. All domains must be administered, and all scoring must be completed in the DEI and THSS by October 3, 2023.
  - Score Report will generate on October 4, 2023
- B. For students not appearing on TOMS roster who are potential ELs based on MISIS HLS, email SSID to Gabby Portaluppi at [gdp9203@lausd.net](mailto:gdp9203@lausd.net)
- C. Refer to REF-6906.6 Fall Census for Elementary and Secondary Schools for information and guidance

#### Elevate Alerts to Prioritize to Meet Program Requirement for Student Enrolled on Census Day October 4th:

1. SELA GERR0001 Required field missing - Primary Language Code (CC14011)
  - All TK-12 students must have a Home Language Survey (HLS) in MiSiS (clear up no shows, and FAX enrollment form with errors on the HLS to SRSB at 213-241-8969)
2. EL 060-0033 - Students missing Current Language Classification and/or Current Language Classification Date (TE-12 only)
  - Assess all potential Emergent Learners with an initial ELPAC (for students not appearing on TOMS roster who are potential ELs based on MISIS HLS, FAX the enrollment form with the SSID to SRSB at 213-241-8969)
3. EL 060-0039 - Students classified as LEP without an English Learner Master Plan Program and EL 060-0170
  - Students enrolled in a Dual Language Education Program (dual, bilingual, maintenance bilingual, transitional) with no master plan program - Enter a Master Plan program for all ELs and students participating in Dual Language Education Programs (students language classification must be in MISIS in order to add the Master Plan Program, newly administered Initial ELPAC test scores take about a week to populate into MISIS and it will designate the Initial Language Classification to the student in MISIS)
4. EL 060-0220 - Any class that has one or more EL or Potential EL students that is missing an EL service section attribute and EL 060-0240
  - Sections with conflicting English Learner Service and Language of Instruction section attributes. All course Sections with 1 or more EL enrolled must have and EL section attribute.
