What's Due

• <u>Pricing Schools: Friday, September 28, 2018 Meal Eligibility Grace Period</u> will end. Pricing school students who do not have a meal eligibility established for the 2018-19 school year will be charged at the full price rate starting October 1, 2018. To get a list of students with a missing meal code, 1) log into the MTAM Dashboard 2) pull up the Detail Student report for the school and 3) check the list of students under the column, Missing Meal Codes.

All students will be able to receive a meal, but students without money will have the full price rate charged to their account. Schools are advised to encourage households to submit a meal application for their student so that a 2018-19 meal eligibility is established as soon as possible.

• Parent Portal Four-Digit Personal Identification Number (PIN)

The requirement for a four-digit Personal Identification Number (PIN) will launch on **Monday, October 1, 2018**, with letters containing the PIN being mailed to assigned legal guardians identified in MiSiS the week of October 1, 2018. The school's address will be used as the return address, and therefore any returned letters must be given directly to the legal guardian.

This new PIN was created to improve security while also simplifying the process of linking a student to a parent's Parent Portal account via using the PIN instead of the student's first and last name. Parents will continue to use the child's LAUSD student identification number and birth date to enroll in the Parent Portal.

Please note the following:

- A parent's PIN code is available to the schools in the MiSiS Focus Dashboard and Reporting System and the Parent Portal Employee Login. This PIN code should only be provided to the assigned legal guardian identified in MiSiS.
- Parents who previously linked their students to the Parent Portal must use the PIN to verify their accounts. They will have 30 days from October 1, 2018, to verify before ITD disables features from their accounts.
- The PIN is a one-time use only. If a PIN reset is required, a principal or designee must use the Parent Portal Employee Login screen to reset the PIN.
