- Principal Portal Assistant Principals now have complete access to all of their assigned schools and can view their schools' Physical Education Certification and Textbook Sufficiency.

What's Due

- **ALL: IT Asset Management** To assist with tracking inventory of computing devices, IT Asset Management is currently working with schools to generate reports of device counts at school sites from *Remedy Asset Manager*. These reports have the following information:
 - o Devices assigned at schools
 - o Devices checked-out to students and faculty
 - O Devices that have been reported lost, stolen, and damaged
 - o Devices that are unaccounted (not returned from FY 2018). Note: These may still be at the school site but show up as missing because they have not been documented in the system.

Please review the reports with your school Instructional Device Manager (IDM). For unaccounted devices, we ask that you locate those devices and update the device status in Remedy.
