Intent

- To understand what English Learner information needs to be entered into MiSiS.
- Provide a coherent and consistent understanding for entering Home Language Survey information in MiSiS.

Implications

- Student Primary Language identifies potential EL students.
- Missing or incorrect data entered into MiSiS results in:
 - unnecessarily tested
 - students not tested
 - incorrect student placement/services
 - inaccurate reporting to CalPads
 - Impacts funding
- Assessments not completed in a timely manner (30 calendar days)
- Parents not receiving information in a timely manner (30 calendar days)

Enrollment Procedures for English Learners

Enrollment Packet

- Home Language Survey (HLS)
- If language other than English in first three questions, refer for language assessment(s)

Instructional Program Options for English Learners



- •Brochures & Videos
- Meeting Log (required)
- When 20 or more EL parents request an alternative, you must begin process to establish program
- RECLASSIFICATION CRITERIA
- •SEI Letter

Assessment

- CELDT (required)
- LAS Links Espanol (optional but highly recommended)
- BINL (optional for other languages)
- DPI to help with placement (secondary)

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
New to LAUSD

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
- New enrollees
 - Home Language Survey (HLS) should be completed by the parent or guardian
 - If the questions to the first three questions is a language other than English, the student is referred for a language assessment
 - If reasonable doubt exists as to whether a student speaks another language other than English, the EL Coordinator needs to be alerted and the student can be tested
 - HLS is to be annotated with "being tested due to reasonable doubt"


 Once the initial CELDT has been administered and preliminarily scored, the other pertinent EL information gets entered into MiSiS: Services > English Learner


Systems
