DID YOU KNOW?

Los Angeles Unified is the nation's second-largest school district.

There are 330 magnet programs are available for K-12 students. Themes include Business, Center for Enriched Studies, Communication Arts, Gifted, Liberal Arts (Humanities, Cooperative Learning), Public Service (Fire/EMT, Police, Medical) STEM, and Visual & Performing Arts. (Only Gifted and Highly Gifted students must be identified or verified as High Achieving.)

Dual language programs are offered in Arabic, Armenian, French, Korean, Mandarin, Japanese and Spanish. Additional world language instruction is also offered in American Sign Language, German, Hebrew, Italian, Latin, Pilipino and Russian.

Los Angeles Unified maintains 24 Wellness Centers, operated by district medical and mental health staff, Federally-Qualified Health Centers and/or County mental health providers, two School Enrollment Placement and Assessment (SEPA) Centers and 22 School Based Health Centers, which are on-campus clinics that provide services directly to students and families.

There are 44 Communities of Schools (CoS), which are groups of schools centered around a neighborhood working to support students, schools and families in the community. Each Community of Schools has a Community of School Administrator and a dedicated support team who are innovating new ways to meet local needs to improve the academic achievement of all students, and form strong connections with local partners such as neighborhood councils, city councils, local businesses and community organizations.






