Academic English Mastery Program (AEMP)

Culturally and Linguistically Responsive (CLR) Summer Institute – During this two-day professional learning opportunity, elementary and secondary educators at Academic English Mastery Schools will explore the connection between culturally and linguistically responsive instructional strategies, Project Based Learning, and increased student achievement.

Elementary and secondary sessions will both take place at 74th Street School on August 9, 2017 and August 10, 2017. The content of the sessions will be differentiated for the appropriate grade levels. Participants will be compensated at the training rate, and will receive the resources needed to integrate the ideas explored into the content areas. Captain Barrington Irving will be the featured guest speaker on Day One of the CLR Summer Institute. He was the youngest African-American pilot to fly solo around the world in a single-engine airplane. Captain Irving attributes much of his success to a teacher who wouldn't let him fail. He will share tips and methods for enriching students' educational experiences with Project Based Learning with teachers who support Standard English Learners at AEMP schools.
