General CTC Requirements: Bilingual Added Authorization



- Hold a valid preliminary / Level I or clear / Level II
 CA credential with an English Learner authorization
- Prove competency in:
 - Language and Communication in the target language (Listening, Speaking, Writing, Reading)
 - Bilingual Education and Bilingualism
 - Geographic, Historical, Sociopolitical, and Sociocultural Contexts of the target language

Language and Communication in the Target Language

(Listening, Speaking, Writing, Reading)

Can be met one of the following ways for iCAAP pathway:

- Hold a Single Subject Secondary Teaching Credential in the target language
- Hold a 3 year or higher degree from a foreign institution in which all instruction was delivered in the target language. (The foreign institution must be equivalent in status to a regionally –accredited institution of higher education in the United States.)
- Pass the Target Language CSET Subtest III
 [Spanish Subtest III (147) or French Subtest III (150) or Korean Subtest III (162) or Mandarin Subtest III (165)]







Bilingual Education and Bilingualism

Can be met one of the following ways:

- Passage of World Languages CSET Subtest IV (250)
- iCAAP Coursework: Curriculum and Methods:
 - 803.2A Foundations of Bilingual Education
 - 803.2B Bilingualism and Biliteracy
 - 803.2C Instructional Methods and Evaluating Curriculum

Geographic, Historical, Sociopolitical, and Sociocultural Contexts of the Target Language

Can be met one of the following ways:

- Passage of CSET Target Language Subtest V
 - Spanish V (258)
 - French V (256)
 - Korean V (262)
 - Chinese V (253)
- iCAAP Coursework available for Spanish ONLY at this time
 - 803.3 Social, Historical, and Cultural Influences on Latino/a Students in Education









Who Can Participate?



Any contracted LAUSD teacher who:

- holds a preliminary, clear, Level I or Level II CA credential
- holds the authorization to teach English Learner students (CLAD or equivalent)
- has access to students in a bilingual setting of the target language
- can be authorized to record video while teaching in the target language



Cost and Logistics



All iCAAP graduate level coursework:

Is tuition waived

- Participants must pay for their books and online platform
- Participants must pay for the exams and any CTC documents
- Will be online via Zoom for Spring 2025.
- Will provide an opportunity for salary points
 - Must complete all hours and homework to a satisfactory level
 - Must complete all three realms of the CA Bilingual Added Authorization




Officially Enroll in Bilingual Added Authorization: BiLAA

- You will be agreeing/acknowledging that:
- You must have the prerequisite credential prior to being recommended for the CTC BiLAA.
- You will need to pay for LiveText's Assessment Insight System™ License: \$139 for seven years via money order before June 1st if you do not already have an active account. Details to be shared at a later time.
- You must meet all three components Language (III), Methods (IV), and
 Sociocultural (V) before being eligible to be recommended for the CTC BiLAA.
- Once requirements are met, the CTC will charge \$102.65 for the Added Authorization.
