

COMPONENT 3

As described in Article X, Section 10.0c of LAUSD/UTLA Bargaining Agreement:

Component Three is a voluntary program designed to provide assistance to nonpermanent and/or permanent teachers who have been positively evaluated, but who wish to avail themselves of such services in order to improve their professional practices. Component Three services are the third priority for the PAR Program, with teachers assigned to schools of greatest need (based upon the State's Accountability Index rankings) to be served first.

As part of Component 3 services, the PAR Program provides an array of professional development workshops designed to meet the needs of teachers across the District.

Component 3 teachers can also request coaching from a PAR Consulting Teacher who provides confidential, targeted support. Consulting Teachers do not evaluate the Component 3 teachers with whom they work.

The PAR Panel, consisting of five UTLA appointed representatives and four District appointed representatives, is the governing body of the PAR Program.

What Do PAR Consulting Teachers Do?

- Maintain confidentiality of observations and discussions with all Participating Teachers
- Help Participating Teachers establish and work toward meaningful goals for planning and delivering instruction as well as maintaining an effective classroom environment.
- Meet regularly with to observe practice and collect student performance data as the basis for collaborative, reflective analysis
- Provide and/or recommend instructional strategies, professional development, and resources

PAR emphasizes teacher professionalism and recognizes that teacher quality positively affects student outcomes.
