## Mentoring

One of the best ways to earn NBC hours is by mentoring. We encourage you to consider this opportunity. Please review the Task 1 Guidelines, made (available via Schoology on Wednesday Sept. 7<sup>th</sup>) for details on the different types of support that are eligible for NBC hours. As you are all aware, we have a significant amount of newly hired teachers to the district that can benefit from colleague support. Some teachers are required to have a mentor assigned to them, others are not. Your first step is to know what type of credentials the teacher holds, and the amount of years they have held the credential. This information can be provided to you by the teacher.
