What is a class code?

Human Resources maintains job descriptions for established certificated positions. These positions or groups of positions are referred to as job "classes" and have class titles and codes by which they are identified. The following is a list of currently active certificated classes in alphabetical order by class title. You may also sort the class descriptions by the class code. Please note, there are no class descriptions for Temporary Adviser positions. If the title or code that you are looking for does not appear on the list, please call a Classification and Compensation Analyst at (213) 241-6356 for assistance.

What if my class code is not here, or I am uncertain of my class code?

Select your class code from this list. If you don't see your class code or are not sure check with your payroll reporter. You should also be able to find your class code on your sign in card.
