## **Additional Information for Provisional Teachers**

## **Mentor Teacher**

The state requires all teachers hired on a Provisional Intern Permit or Short Term Staff Permit to work with a District-assigned Mentor.

There is no mandatory paperwork to be completed by Provisional teachers other than updating the Online Profile and Personalized Program Plan and notifying the district of changes in your status. The Mentor will help you acclimate to the school and district, classroom set-up, district priorities and initiatives, home/school communication, and lesson planning as appropriate for each teacher.

The Goal for Provisional Teachers - Intern Program--District or University

Once you have completed your subject matter competency requirements, you must be accepted into an Internship Program. The District Internship Program or a University Internship Program will meet this requirement.
