As we enter the spring season, let us pause and celebrate our collective accomplishments as a unified family. We initiated the year in training to learn and make the Parent Advisory Committee experience unique to each of us. We also want to shed light on the **budget development process**, an annual cycle led at every school. School site leaders, families, and secondary students review assets, school community needs, and data. In addition, they recommend how categorical and school site budgets are to be spent for the new school year. We encourage you to attend two school site forums where the community is engaged in the budget development conversation:

- **School Site Council:** Specifically reviews Title I funds focused on funding interventions, resources to accelerate learning, and family engagement.
- **Annual School Goals and Budget Consultation Meeting:** This is a new requirement for school sites that are asked to engage the community, including parents and students, to advise how all categorical and general fund dollars may be spent on a school campus.
