

## Community Advisory Committee (CAC) Administrator's Report February 17, 2021



#### **Greetings**

The Los Angeles Unified is beginning the budget development process for the 2021-22 school year. This past semester our school site School Site Councils (SSC) and English Learner Advisory Committees (ELAC) began the process to learn about the School Plan for Student Achievement, which includes reviewing supports in place for high need students, including students with disabilities, African-American, and English Learners to name a few. School based committees and councils learned about key data trends and progress for subgroups, and began to review recommendations. The SSC and ELAC are important bodies of leaders organized to help schools organize how they support English proficiency and prepare students to stay on a college and career path. To help support this objective it is important for you as members of the Community Advisory Committee to engage with your child's school during the budget development process.

Deputy Superintendent Riley, like last year, will release a communication inviting school leaders to engage SSC, ELAC and the community at large in the budget development process. This process includes leading and studying Asset and Needs Assessment findings, guiding participants through a study of data and sub group trends, and to tell the story about how the budget is organized to address student and school needs. - ✓ **COVID-19 Testing:** Our District leadership is continuing to organize testing for students and staff participating in school site services. ## Responsibilities Assigned to the CAC

The CAC shall advise the school district governing board on at least the following tasks:

 Advising the policy and administrative entity of the special education local plan area regarding the development, amendment, and review of the local plan. The entity shall review and consider comments from the community advisory committee.



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- Recommending annual priorities to be addressed by the plan.
- Assisting in parent education and in recruiting parents and other volunteers who may contribute to the implementation of the plan.
- Encouraging community involvement in the development and review of the local plan.
- Supporting activities on behalf of individuals with exceptional needs.
- Assisting in parent awareness of the importance of regular school attendance.
- Supporting community involvement in the parent advisory committee established pursuant to Section 52063 to encourage the inclusion of parents of individuals with exceptional needs to the extent these pupils also fall within one or more of the definitions in Section 42238.01
