We initiated the year in training to learn and make the Community Advisory Committee experience unique to each of us. We proceeded to learning in our Parliamentary procedures course, followed by Understanding Data and, we recently completed Developing SMART Comments. We also want to shed light on the **budget development process**; an annual cycle led at every school. School site leaders, families, and secondary students review assets, school community needs, and data. In addition, they recommend how categorical and school site budgets are to be spent for the new school year. We encourage you to attend two school site forums where the community is engaged in the budget development conversation:

- **School Site Council:** Specifically reviews Title I funds focused on funding interventions, resources to accelerate learning, and family engagement.
- Annual School Goals and Budget Consultation Meeting: This is a new requirement for school sites that are asked to engage the community, including parents and students, to advise how all categorical and general fund dollars may be spent on a school campus.

## **Responsibilities Assigned to the CAC**

#### The CAC shall advise the school district governing board on at least the following tasks:

- 1. Advising the policy and administrative entity of the special education local plan area regarding the development, amendment, and review of the local plan. The entity shall review and consider comments from the community advisory committee.
- 2. Recommending annual priorities to be addressed by the plan.
- 3. Assisting in parent education and in recruiting parents and other volunteers who may contribute to the implementation of the plan.
- 4. Encouraging community involvement in the development and review of the local plan.
- 5. Supporting activities on behalf of individuals with exceptional needs.
- 6. Assisting in parent awareness of the importance of regular school attendance.
- 7. Supporting community involvement in the parent advisory committee established pursuant to Section 52063 to encourage the inclusion of parents of individuals with exceptional needs to the extent these pupils also fall within one or more of the definitions in Section 42238.01
