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### **Responsibilities Assigned to the DELAC**

DELAC Committees shall advise the school board on at least the following topics:

- 1. Developing the District's Master Plan for Academic Programs and Services for English Learners. The district's Master Plan will take into account the school site master plans.
- 2. Conducting of a district wide needs assessment on a school-by-school basis.
- 3. Establishment of district program, goals, and objectives for programs and services for English learners.
- 4. Development of a plan to ensure compliance with any applicable teacher and/or teacher aide requirements.
- 5. Review and comment on the school district reclassification procedures
- 6. Review and comment on the written notifications required to be sent to parents and guardians.
- 7. If the DELAC acts as the English Learner Advisory Committee under California Education Code sections 52063(b)(1) and 52062(a)(2), the DELAC shall also review and comment on the Local Control and Accountability or annual update about the development of the Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP) or the Annual Update to the LCAP.
- 8. DELAC reviews and provides advice on the development of the Consolidated Application (Con App).
