<p>1. Can you provide a 504-parent workshop at the school site?</p>	<p>Each school site has a Section 504 Designee trained on Section 504 procedures and can assist parents with questions regarding Section 504. School administrators and/or designees are able to contact the Educational Equity Compliance Office for support. <p>2. What data is available regarding students who are experiencing homelessness or are foster youth?</p>	<p>We are unable to share Section 504 plan data regarding students who are experiencing homelessness or are foster youth.</p>
<p>3. Is there a surrogate parent training program?</p>	<p>Yes. Each appointed surrogate parent is trained by the LAUSD-SELPA Surrogate Parent team. In addition, once appointed they are invited to attend all District and community training available to parents.</p>
