

PAC Legislative Subcommittee Report

During this 2022–2023 year, we have learned and gotten to know the work carried out by LAUSD’s Office of Government Relations lead by Mrs. Martha Alvarez. We have spoken about the Los Angeles Unified School District’s financial and legislative priorities; advocating for changes in policy so that schools are safe and welcoming spaces for equitable learning to reach academic achievement for all students. They have an advocating agenda that aligns with the District’s Strategic Plan 2022–2026. LAUSD is a member that has an impact in local, state, national and global communities.

The Office of Government Relations will continue to advocate for initiatives and legislative policies that align with LAUSD’s Strategic Plan.

These are some of those proposals:

AB 439– Acquisition of contracts through work orders.

AB 483– Local education agency program for Medi-Cal billing.

SB 98– Student Enrollment Funding. This advocates for school allocations to be based on enrollment and not attendance.

SB 223– Child Welfare and Support so to have more counselors.

SB 515– Shade Structure. This is for a process to be easier in schools.

SB 551- Expansion of School Site Behavioral Health Services. This is for further collaboration with other school districts and to assign existing funds for Mental Health.
