Dr. Alfonzo Webb and Dr. Roberto Martinez shared a steering committee had been formed around the achievement gap of Black students in LAUSD. This steering committee includes students, parents, district staff and community members to be responsible for oversight and accountability over the funds being used to help close the achievement gap of black students.

The following things were shared as to where they would spend the money allocated due to the reduction of school police in LAUSD. Monies will target Curriculum, Teacher Professional Development, School Curriculum Grants,

Community Partnership, Community Schools, School Climate & Wellness, Psychiatric Social Worker, Counselors, School Climate Coaches, Restorative Justice Advisors and lastly Flexible Climate Grants. There will be 53 Targeted schools with a minimum of 100 Black students to receive services.

Our next meeting, we will talk about what was presented and how it is aligned to the groups vision. We will also discuss if there are any suggestion for the steering committee formed to consider adding to their strategies and initiative presented to our subcommittee.
