Mr. Plascencia from the Office of Parent and Community Services, shared he would invite Dr. Webb from the Office of School Operations and Roberto Martinez, Associate Superintendent of School Culture and Climate to speak on the 25 million to be invested to help close the achievement gap for African American families. Mr. Plascencia also stated that Mr. Webb and Mr. Martinez would be able to speak to the possibility of forming a Centralized African American Advisory Committee.

Another guest speaker was Mr. Wes Hall, Educational Consultant. He shared strategies on how to close the achievement gaps for African American students. Mr. Hall also talked about the Board Resolution 104-16/17 *Volunteering on the Clock* passed on October 10, 2017. The Board resolution stipulates District employees are encouraged to volunteer in schools during the work day for two hours per month through the Village Movement Mentoring Program.

Member Mr. Lemus shared the importance and benefits of teacher student mentorship.
