## Group Discussion & Recommendations:

-Track new bill SB-692, introduced by Cortese -LCAP; state priorities: least restrictive environment - Act to amend section 47607.3, 52060,52064.5, 52066, 52071, 52701.5 & add & repeal section 56139 of the Education Code relating to Special education- (include the percentage of students w/disabilities being in a general education class 80% of the school day as a state LCAP goal. \*Set for Senate hearing 3/17. (Mayra Zamora will track & update committee)

-Legislative updates, advocacy & intervention before law is made & invite Legislators

-Invite Legislators to be guest speakers to subcommittee/ PAC –\* Invite Assembly member (D-Long Beach) Patrick O'Donnell, Chair of Assembly Education Committee

-Focus on connecting African American students to additional resources and funding to meet student achievement needs & narrow the gaps. How can we make change to include African American students to the student population groups under LCAP.

-What can we say as a PAC group to legislative groups that relates to the LCAP

**Office of Government Relations (OGR):** from Martha Alvarez, *Director of OGR* & Colleen Pagter, *Legislative Liaison* Ms. Martha Alvarez spoke the last ten minutes to the committee regarding Sacramento legislation budget conversations on bils related to LCFF and had Q&A.

- AB-531, Introduced, Quirk-Silva = Education finance: local control funding formula: supplemental & concentration grantsbill requires each school district, county office, of education & charter school to identify unspent supplemental & concentration grant funds by annually reconciling and reporting the State Dept of Ed

-AB-533 – An act to add Section 42238.08 to the Education Code relating to education finance

-Board still evaluating AB-692, Cortese.. have not taken position yet

-Feb 19.2021- deadline for submitting new bills

-Request for OGR to share with PAC Legislation Subcommittee any new state legislation for African American students -Current legislative and funding priorities at this moment is focus on safe re-opening efforts for school; meeting needs of community during COVID-19 & Access and Support for ALL Students
