



Accessing Open Data LCAP Dashboard

1. Go to <https://opendata.lausd.net/>.
2. Click on the Open Data Dashboard (this will open a new tab).





3. Go to “Select Dashboard View” and select Local Control Accountability Plan.





Exploring Open Data LCAP Dashboard


1. The LCAP Dashboard is organized by LCAP Goals - you can click on these tabs at the top to see the metrics and data for each Goal




2. Within each Goal, you can see the LCAP metrics listed at the top - use the arrows to the right and left to scroll and see more metrics, and click on the metric you'd like to explore.




- As you scroll down, you'll see a description of the metric, as well as the 2023-24 LCAP targets for that metric, including the student group targets.




- Beneath that, you'll see the three most recent available years of data (these are overall data points for the entire District).




- Next, you'll see the data for those same three years, broken out by Board District, Local District, Community of Schools, School Type, Affiliated Charter, Partnership, and Magnet. Click on any of these buttons to see that data breakdown.




- You'll also see that the District overall data still appears as a comparison point on the graphs, so that you can see each unit's performance relative to the overall District performance.




- If you want to explore all the LCAP data for a particular Board District, Local District, or Community of Schools, click on the “Profile +” Button and a new tab will open with that Profile.




- From there, if you keep scrolling down, you will see Student Group breakdowns. Use the buttons at the top to explore the District’s data broken down by LCAP Student Groups, Grade Level, Gender, Ethnicity, Language Classification, Poverty, and Students with Disability.



- Again, you'll see that the District overall data still appears as a comparison point on the graphs, so that you can see each student group's performance compared to the overall District performance.



- Next, you can see the school-level breakdown for that metric.




