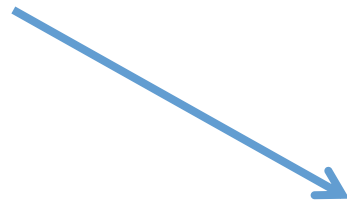

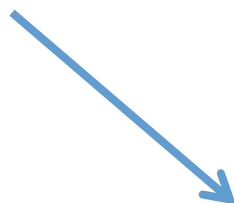

Suspension Notices		
▼ What is a suspension?		
Suspension is a disciplinary action in response to student misconduct that constitute violation of the Education Code Sections 48900, 48900.2, 48900.3, 48900.4, 48900.7, or 48915. A student may be suspended from school by the principal or from class by the teacher. In LAUSD, there are three types of suspension (see below). A school suspension may not exceed five (5) consecutive school days and a Pupil Suspension Notice must be given to the parent/guardian each time a student is suspended. The Pupil Suspension Notice will specify the Education Code violation, the effective day and duration of suspension, and the post-suspension parent conference date. (NOTE: No student shall be penalized for his or her parent's failure to attend a conference with a school official. The return of a suspended student shall not be contingent up on attendance by the student's parent at the school conference.)

Please note that the parent's identity must be verified before providing the child's GATE eligibility status via telephone. The District is currently exploring options to distribute confidential information that is compliant with District protocol/standards. Intellectual Ability assessment scores are not available during school closures. Updates will be provided as they are available.

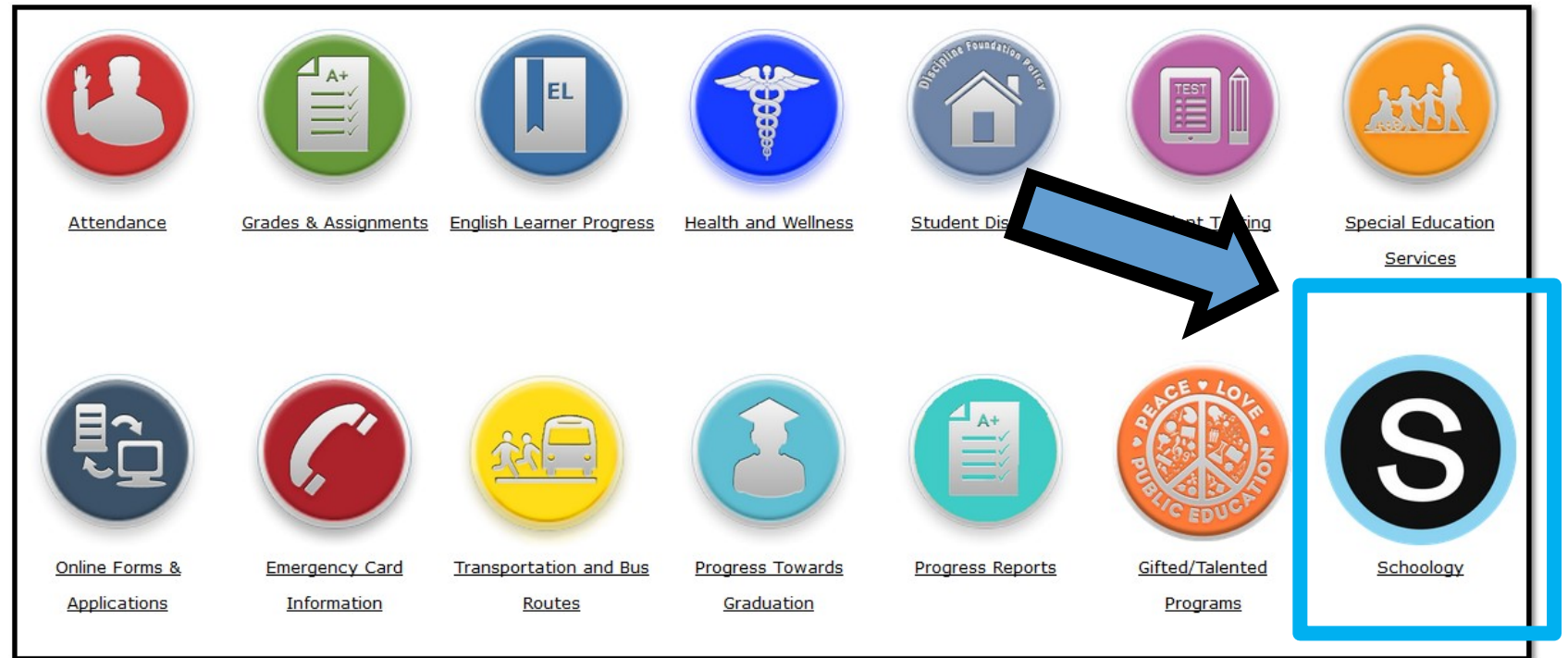
